

The Not So Newlywed Game

Summary

The live *Not So Newlywed Game* is an exact replica of the television game using four married couples who are either newlyweds or feel like newlyweds. (In other words, it doesn't matter how long they have been married.) The show consists of Bob narrating 15 minutes of hilarious clips from the television show and then playing a half-hour version of the game. The *Not So Newlywed Game* is always funny and is a great entertainment opportunity for a company, organization or fair. The show is of good taste and is absolutely hilarious.

The actual television show went on the air in 1966 and is still running on the Game show network in more than 100 cities in the United States. The Newlywed Game was on the ABC Television Network for eight years daytime and nighttime and rated higher than its competition: Andy Williams, Jackie Gleason, Flipper, Laugh-In and Gunsmoke. In the mid-70's it was the number one syndicated television show in the nation. In December 2001, two-time Emmy Award winner Bob Eubanks was honored with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame because of his illustrious career in television.

Client Preparation

To present the live *No So Newlywed Game*, the client must provide:

- A prize for the winning couple as well as consolation prizes. (The quality of the prizes is up to the client.)
- Eight chairs
- Four microphones on stands for the couples
- One hand-held wireless microphone for Bob
- A podium

- Three production assistants to keep score, and to escort the contestants on and off the stage to a soundproof area

Audio Visual Requirements

- VCR playback machine with projector
- A screen large enough for the entire audience to see
- A CD player to play the show theme music throughout the presentation
- An AV technician to work with Bob during a rehearsal and during his performance

Notes

- Bob flies full fare coach and prefers to book his own flights. Arrangements need to be made for ground transportation in the destination city. Hotel room requirements are nonsmoking King with late arrival guaranteed. Hotel address and phone number should be provided

To assure drawing a large crowd, every couple in the audience for the live *Not So Newlywed Game* should have an equal chance of becoming a contestant on the live show. We suggest that every couple who wishes to be contestants should put their names in a hopper prior to the show and then Bob Eubanks will draw the names at the beginning of the presentation. This assures enthusiasm from the entire audience.
