



ROSS SHAFER AV REQUIREMENTS

LAPTOP CONNECTION: Ross brings his own Apple MacBook Pro laptop. He prefers an HDMI connection; however, he will also bring DVI and VGA dongle connectors.

SLIDE ADVANCE: He brings his own Perfect Cue RF Wireless. Ross's slides are generated using Apple's Keynote software program (*NOT Microsoft PowerPoint*).

WHAT ABOUT LOADING HIS SLIDES ON YOUR SYSTEM? Ross uses his own proprietary material, as well as video clips and photos. Therefore, he **does not load his slide program** on any other computers or systems.

AUDIO: If Ross is giving a **SPEECH** a wireless lavalier microphone is preferred. Ross also incorporates many embedded videos clips in his presentation. Ross requires a COMPUTER AUDIO connection through his laptop's 3.5mm adapter headphone jack. If Ross is doing a **STANDUP COMEDY ACT** he requires a wired handheld mic with a mic stand.

IMAG: If you use Image Magnification (IMAG), Ross needs one screen devoted to his slides. Why? His slides are used as punch lines and timing effects. If you use only one screen, Ross' slides need to be on the screen 100% of the time.
